



## ECG de mayo de 2020

A 72-year-old man was admitted to the general surgery department after a Hartmann intervention for diverticulitis. On different days after the operation, he required attention for tachyarrhythmia that always remitted with carotid sinus massage. **Figure 1** shows the response to one of the massages (the expanded traces reflect different times in the response: Left panel, V<sub>5</sub>-V<sub>6</sub> capture the end of the tachycardia; Right panel, aVF and V<sub>1</sub> show the ongoing response to massage). **Figure 2** shows the baseline electrocardiogram.
