ANNOUNCEMENT OF 2005 AWARDS FOR ARTICLES PUBLISHED IN THE REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA

SPANISH SOCIETY OF CARDIOLOGY AWARDS FOR THE BEST ARTICLES PUBLISHED IN THE REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA

Amount: €15 000

Basis:

1. The purpose of these awards is to encourage the publication of high-quality original articles in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA.
2. A first prize of €7000 euros and 2 second prizes, one of €5000 euros and 1 of €3000 euros, will be awarded through the Fundación Casa del Corazón (Heart House Foundation).
3. The awards will be given annually and under no circumstances will be declared void.
4. All original articles published in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA during 2004 are eligible. Articles published as editorials, special articles, or review papers are not eligible for these awards.
5. The editor-in-chief and the associate editors of the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA will pre-select what they consider to be the 6 best articles published in the journal in 2004 after consulting with the presidents of the scientific divisions sections of the Spanish Society of Cardiology.
6. The jury that will make the final selection of the 3 articles to receive awards will be overseen by the vice president of the Spanish Society of Cardiology and will also consist of the editor-in-chief of the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA and the members of the SCS grants and awards committee of the Spanish Society of Cardiology. The final decision is not subject to appeal.
7. The awards will be given at a ceremony that will take place during the Congreso de las Enfermedades Cardiovasculares (Congress on Cardiovascular Diseases), to be held in Barcelona from the 26th to the 29th of October, 2005.

AWARDS FROM THE SPANISH SOCIETY OF CARDIOLOGY FOR ARTICLES PUBLISHED IN THE REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA WITH THE GREATEST INTERNATIONAL IMPACT

Amount: €24 000

Basis:

1. The purpose of these awards is to encourage the publication in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA of original articles that have an important impact or

repercussion, both in the medium- and long-term, on the international scientific community.

2. A first prize of €6000 euros and 2 second prizes of €3000 euros will be awarded to those articles with long-term impact, and another first prize of €6000 euros and 2 second prizes of €3000 will be awarded to those articles with the greatest medium-term impact, through the Fundación Casa del Corazón (Heart House Foundation).

3. The awards will be given annually and under no circumstances will be declared voidare to be awarded each roid.

4. All original articles published in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA will be eligible. Articles published as editorials, special articles or review papers are not eligible for these awards.

5. The impact of the published articles will be measured by the number of reference citations received by the article published in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA from journals per the Science Citation Index Expanded™.

6. For the award to the article with the most significant long-term international impact, the reference citations for articles published in the journal in 1999 that have been cited during the years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004 will be determined. For the award to the article with the most significant medium-term international impact, the reference citations for articles published in the journal during 2002 that have been cited during the years 2003 and 2004 will be determined.

7. Calculation of the number of reference citations per the SCI for each article will be determined by an organization independent of the journal and the Spanish Society of Cardiology that will issue an annual report on the topic.



AWARDS FROM THE CLINICAL AND OUTPATIENT CARDIOLOGY SECTION FOR ARTICLES ON PUBLISHED IN THE REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA

Amount: €2400

Basis:

1. The Clinical and Outpatient Cardiology Section, in order to encourage and promote the submission of articles and/or scientific reviews in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA among section members, announces 2 prizes of €1200 euros each, through the

Fundación Casa del Corazón (Heart House Foundation), to the best articles on clinical cardiology published in the journal during 2004.

2. One of the awards will be reserved for section members who have been members for at least 1 year.

3. The jury will be composed of 2 members of the Clinical and Outpatient Cardiology Section and the editor-in-chief of the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA or the person he designates. The final decision is not subject to appeal. The practical interest and scientific content of the study will be evaluated.

1. The prize is €1800, through the Fundación Casa del Corazón (Heart House Foundation).

2. All original articles on pediatric cardiology and congenital heart disease published in the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA during 2004 are eligible for this award.

3. The evaluating body will consist of the president and the secretary of the Pediatric Cardiology and Congenital Cardiopathy Heart Disease Section of the Spanish Society of Cardiology and the editor-in-chief of the REVISTA ESPAÑOLA DE CARDIOLOGÍA.


Basis:


