Response to ECG, February 2017



Respuesta al ECG de febrero de 2017

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The correct answer is number 4. This dual-chamber pacemaker is functioning normally. There are 2 leads, 1 for pacing the Bachmann interatrial bundle and the other for pacing the bundle of His. The resulting bipolar physiological Hisian pacing does not lead to any changes in QRS morphology ([Figure 1](#)).

Given the particular features of pacing in this case, there is no loss of capture (answers 1 and 2) because all the spikes are still present in the QRS complex. Twiddler syndrome (answer 3) is ruled out by chest x-ray ([Figure 2](#)).


