Response to ECG, November 2014

Respuesta al ECG de noviembre de 2014

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Extensive acute anterior myocardial infarction, accompanied by predictors of poor prognosis. There is evident QRS distortion in leads V₂, V₃, V₄, and aVL, with a J point to R wave ratio > 0.5. ST segment alternans is also observed. Both are signs of a poorer prognosis (Figure).

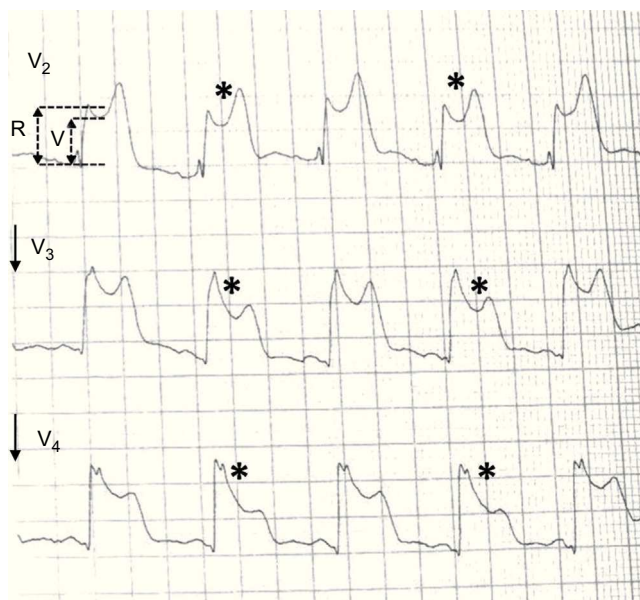
